Scope of Work

Background

The IAEG-SDGs Working Group on Geospatial Information (IAEG-SDGs: WGGI) at its First Expert Group Meeting on 12-14 December 2016 in Mexico City established six task teams to consider and work on identified issues, one of which is the geographic perspective on Indicator 9.1.1 *“Proportion of the Rural Population who Live Within 2 Km of an All-Season Road”*.

Scope

The Task Team seeks to –

- Briefly review the status of the current metadata entry in the SDG Indicators Metadata repository (available online);
- Document national experiences from among task team members including through research, informed survey and inquiry from their country stakeholders on matters concerning broadly on this particular indicator; and
- Provide brief overview of current for geospatial and earth observations data availability and techniques that could be used to provide information to augment and support the indicator, illustrated by one or more case studies.
