- 274 200 Km²
- 19 million inhabitants
 - 52% women
 - +75% rural
 - +55% Under 20
- Administrative subdivision: 13 regions, 45 provinces, 351 communes (49 urban and 302 rural communes) and 8228 villages

- □ 5 years (2019-2014)

- ☐ Goal: to increase investment in land and rural productivity through improved land security and land management,
- □ Expected results: increased confidence in the land security and increased efficiency of the institutions in charge of the land

 - Component 2: "Institutional Development and Capacity Building"
 - Component 3: "Site-specific land interventions"
