





WG2 Resolutions from 12th UN-GGIM-AP Plenary Meeting (Bali, Indonesia @November 2023) (1 of 2)

- Recognizing the importance of the strategic work plan 2023-2035 of the Expert Group on Land Administration and Management (EG- LAM);
- Implementing the Framework for Effective Land Administration (FELA) at <u>the national level</u> and in collaboration with regional committees, functional groups and international organizations;
- Encourage member States to engage in the Framework for Effective Land Administration, especially by translating it in their own languages and practically implementing it, leverage the UN-IGIF Implementation Guide, and work with the UN-GGIM Expert Group on Land Administration and Management;

WG2 Resolutions from 12th UN-GGIM-AP Plenary Meeting (Bali, Indonesia @November 2023) (2 of 2)



- Aligning effective land administration and the integration of the terrestrial, built, maritime and cadastral domains with the United Nations Integrated Geospatial Framework (UN-IGIF) to support climate change and building disaster resilience, planning, etc.;
- *Re-affirming* of key principles in **fit-for-purpose**, **interoperability**, **sustainability**, **flexibility** and **inclusiveness** in effective and efficient land administration processes and systems;
- *Emphasizing* the need to **strengthen the human capacity** and **capability** in areas related to land administration and management including data collection, systems, institutional or legal framework, and other pertinent sectors;
- *Recognizing* leveraging synergies, avoid duplication through collaboration with other working groups of UN-GGIM-AP; and international organisations, such as FIG
- Encouraging member states to send their delegates to share information and exchange knowledge
- Acknowledging the memberships of Australia and China in WG 2
