The United Kingdom welcomes the report from the Geospatial Working Group on Geospatial Information of the Inter-Agency and Expert Group on Sustainable Development Goal Indicators and notes the progress in identifying the value that geospatial data brings to the SDG process.

In particular, the emphasis on geospatial standards to underpin SDG reporting is an important component in ensuring that statistical and geospatial data systems can interact.
