Indonesia started this program this year to monitor SDGs indicators in smaller scope, namely at the village administrative area. The Ministry of National Development Planning, Geospatial Information Agency (BIG) and Central Bureau of Statistic (BPS) heve been working together on this project. BIG as the agency responsible for geospatial information has successfully completed mapping village boundaries in 2019, while BPS annually collects and present statistical data. Those will be integrated and will form the basis for the development of the Indoensian Geospatial-Statistical Framework (IGSF). | |
| In 2021, the development of the ISGF will continue on the data available for 2020. Finalization of ISGF and standardization of statistical data formats will also be carried out this year.
