<i>Statement:</i> Singapore commends OGC's progress in developing open standards through its initiatives for supporting smart, safe and resilient cities, which are crucial to achieving interoperability and adoption in emerging areas such as 3D, indoor and underground. Singapore has adopted OGC open standards in 3D GIS systems development, such as in OneMap 3D, a 3D map for public use, and the Singapore Underground Data Model. As part of future technology exploration, Singapore also looks at using Geospatial Artificial Intelligence to help augment the data acquisition process for map creation. Singapore is willing to contribute towards furthering technology frontiers, and welcomes collaborations with other countries on this front.
