We would like to recognize the efforts that the Geodesy subcomitte and its groups have taken to achieve their planned objetives. We would also like to recognize that the efforts taken to meet the requirements established on the 9/104 decision within the context of this difficult time of the COVID 19 pandemic. In particular, the questionnaires application to international services.
This is especially relevant for the Geodesy Asociation, since an adequate communication with the scientific sector is the key to coordinate efforts between State Members in order to be in accordance with the geodetic science and its needs.
The sustainability of the global geodetic reference frame is adequate since it is based on the issues set on the 4th general assembly at the resolution 69/266.
These consolidating actions aimed at maintaining and improving the GGRF, have kept the link of successful experiences established on the implementation plan to ensure no one is left behind.
The concept of excellence on the global geodetic center may be improved through the dissemination and feedback from State Members and the differents actors involved on the Geodetic Field to strengthen its eventual implementation.
We suggest the working groups related to the geodetic reference frame of the UN-GGIM regional committees to review and provide feedback on both documents (position and concept), regardless of open consultations to State Members that are not part of these groups and other organizations related to the GGRF.
