<i>Statement:</i> Brazil through IBGE has been joining efforts to improve the integration of geospatial information and statistics to ensure an integrated analysis of information that supports the implementation of public policies in favor of making environmentally sustainable decisions, and in support of the implementation of the SDGs. To this end, IBGE has sought to insert itself in the guidelines determined by the committee, combining traditional and non-traditional sources, such as administrative records and observation of land images to meet the proposed and priority indicators. We reaffirm here our position and commitment regarding the 2030 Agenda and its 17 SDGs, with regard to the dependence on geospatial information, since in our view all the activities that impact society and the environment occur in a place where " occurs "is fundamental to the definition of the action.
