Statement:

- The Netherlands welcomes particularly the broad global consultation and iterative steps in the review and editing resulting in the final draft of the Framework for Effective Land Administration (FELA).
- The Netherlands believes that FELA is a valuable asset in helping Member States to strengthen and modernise its land administration and management processes and systems.
