A. Background

During the seventh session of the UN Committee of Experts on Global Geospatial Information Management, the National Institutional Arrangements Working Group (NIA-WG) presented an overarching framework for implementing national institutional arrangements in geospatial information management organisations, which consisted of principles, instruments and guidelines; as well as a compendium of global good practices of implementation of national institutional arrangements instruments.

The Committee of Experts endorsed the overarching framework and agreed that a next step could be the development of an easy-to-understand guide that would facilitate the use of the principles and instruments for users not familiar with geospatial information management concepts.
