

Q1 2022

5th Virtual Meeting

A new Co-Chair was designated.

HLG-IGIF Plan of Work was reviewed and finalized.

HLG-IGIF Communications Strategy and Plan finalized.



Q2 2022

1st In-Person Meeting

Formed 3 Working Groups and selected six Co-Leads.

Finalized proposed UN-GGIM report to ECOSOC and draft resolution with Friends of UN-GGIM Co-Chairs on E/RES/2016/27.

Launched HLG-IGIF Newsletter.



Q3 2022

Widespread Engagement

Completed IGIF Branding Package, began widespread engagement.

Held two IGIF Side Events at the UN-GGIM 12th Session to engage:

- Regional Committee Chairs
- Donors and funders
- Member States advancing
 IGIF to share lessons learned
