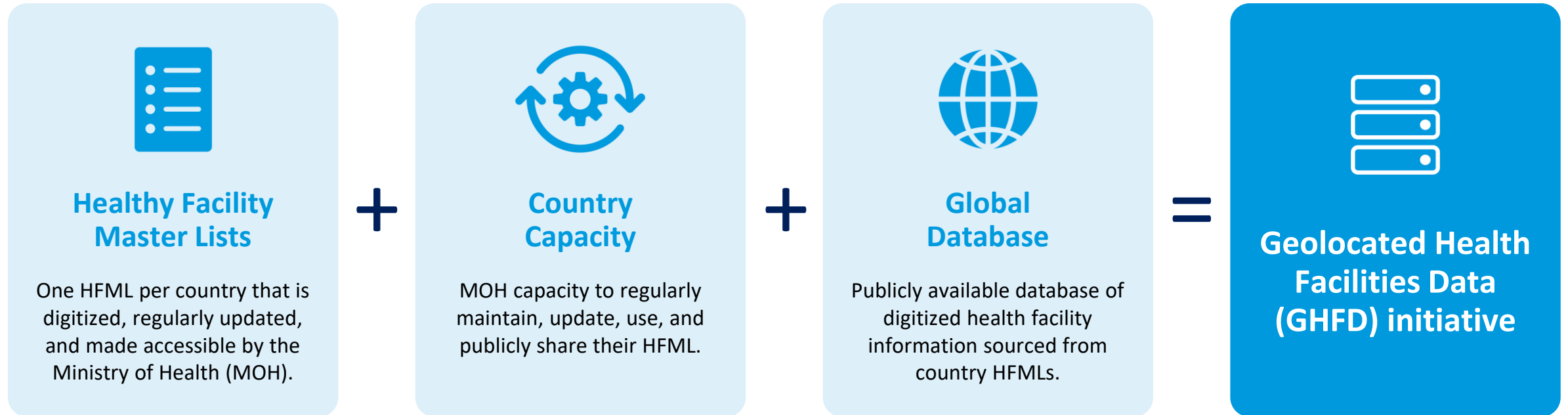

Objectives



Geolocated Health Facilities Data (GHFD) Initiative Impact

- Increase country level capacity to have a regularly updated health facility master list (HFML) that is seen as the singular source of health facility data
- Make geolocated health facility data accessible
- Leverage and use data rather than simply collect it
- Harness technical capacity to strengthen health systems and delivery
- Increase data interoperability and coordination
- Avoid duplication
- Advance progress toward the SDGs, Triple Billion targets and Universal Health Coverage

Support for HFMLs

The GHFD initiative works with MOHs to:

Manage four data elements:

- 1 Unique ID
- 2 Name
- 3 Type
- 4 Location

Share them publicly via:

- 1 MOH Website
- 2 Global Database

Promote:

- 1 One National HFML
- 2 Interoperability
- 3 Reduced duplication

NOTE: Each HFML will have health facility definition, classification table, and metadata.

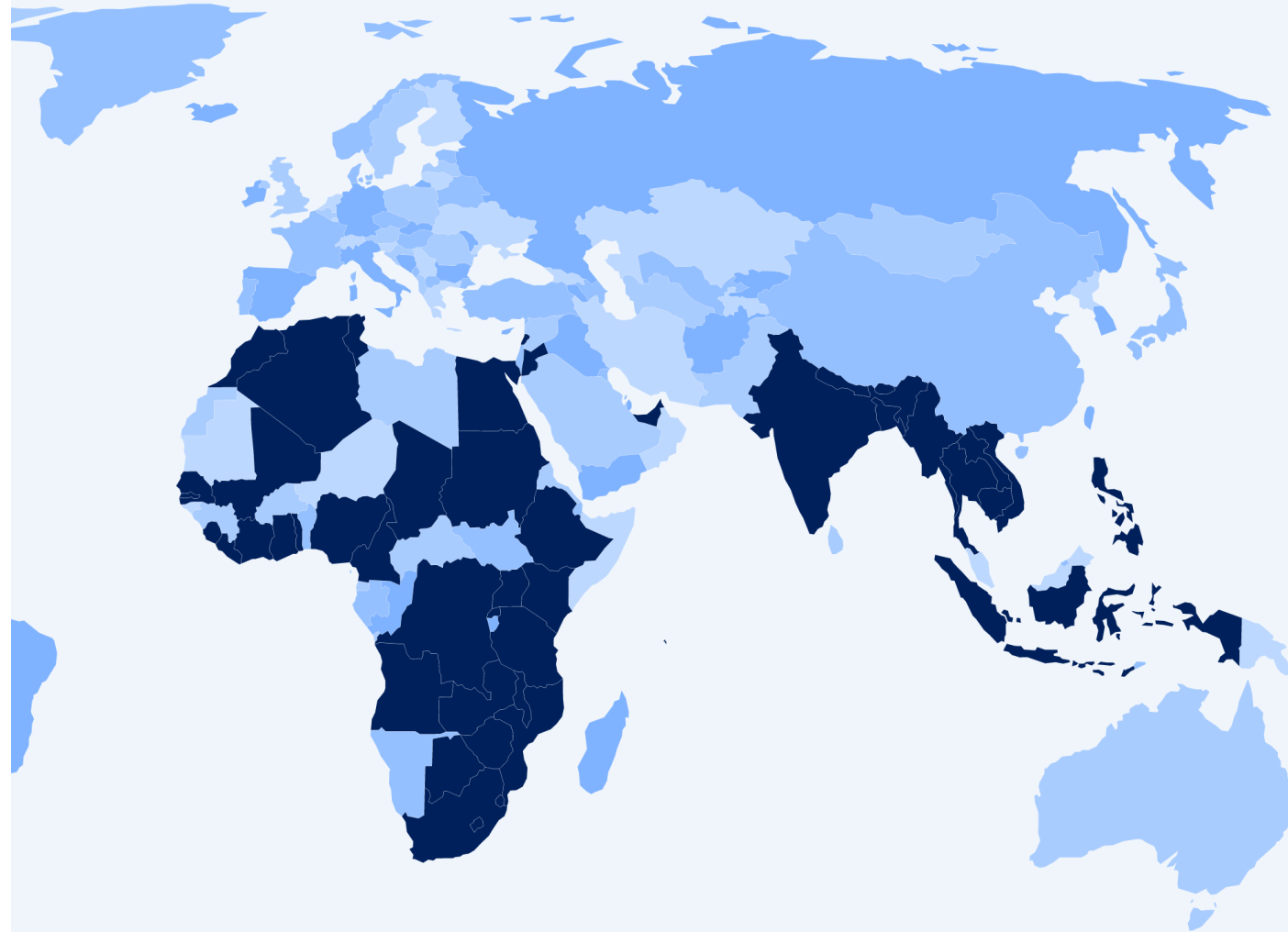
GHFD Coordination Structure
