European Geodesy Forum 2021

Global geodesy forum (April '21) -> European Geodesy Forum (June '21):

- Articulated need for a European Community of Interest
- Align and support the UN-GGIM Subcommittee on Geodesy's priorities for the Global Geodetic Reference Frame, and to translate them into actions relevant for UN-GGIM: Europe
- Representing and supporting regional (European) interests at UN-GGIM





UN-GGIM: Europe

- 2021: renewed strategy outlining the mission of UN-GGIM: Europe
 Maximise the use of geospatial information in Europe for a safer and more sustainable world.
- Five key priority areas:
 - Integrated Geospatial Information Framework
 - Sustainable Development Goals
 - Data Integration
 - Data Strategy and Policy
 - Geodetic Reference Frames





UN-GGIM: Europe

- 2022: survey of the Strategy Project Team




- 2022: kick-off meeting organized by the Strategy Project Team
 - Develop concept note
 - Find interested parties and lead
 - Propose Community of Interest: a 'light touch' group which is more of a liaison between the interests of UN-GGIM: Europe and existing global and regional activities in topic area.

 - Focus on growing and sustaining the geodesy profession
 - Act as a coordination body liaising with and between established domestic and international programmes and bringing different communities together.





Administrative Roadmap 2023-2025



Time



- 2023: First Discussion Round
 - Lack of trained geodesists
 - Lack of geodetic programs at universities
 - Need for awareness raising with decision-makers
 - Avoid duplication of effort (Community of Interest)
 - Link to global (UN-GGIM / UN-SCoG / UN-GGCE)





- Draft extended objectives GRF Europe:
 - Provide support and actions that further the aims of the Global Geodetic Centre of Excellence
 - Align and support the UN-GGIM Subcommittee on Geodesy's priorities for the Global Geodetic Reference Frame, and to translate them into actions relevant for UN-GGIM: Europe
 - Act as a coordination body liaising with and between established national/regional and international programmes and bringing different geodetic stakeholders together
 - Focus on growing and sustaining the geodesy profession
 - Assist European Members States on topics related to geospatial information
 - Foster decision-making based on geodesy as and when required
 - Engage European experts to contribute to UN-GGIM / Sub-Committee on Geodesy / UN-GGCE





- Concrete achievements:
 - Presented GRF Europe at EUREF23
 - Build up contact list of national POC's in support of the UN-GGCE Listening World Tour
 - Establish communication with regional groups
 - Assist Member States in finding help with regards to specific geospatial questions
 - Work with European agency on recommendation with regards to geodetic reference frames
