Administrative arrangements for the meeting

The Third Meeting of the UN-GGCE International Advisory Committee together with the Fifth Plenary Meeting of the Subcommittee on Geodesy and the Third UN-GGCE Steering Committee Meeting will be held from 10 to 14 March 2025 at the UN Campus, Bonn, Germany. The meeting will be from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. However, for Monday, 10 March the meeting will start at 10:00 a.m. to facilitate any visitor pass requirements and can be expected to end at 02:00 p.m. on Friday, 14 March.

FAQ to facilitate entry into Germany

Immigration Requirements

When entering Germany, you will need to show the following documents, depending on your nationality:

- EU nationals: Valid passport or national ID card.
- Non-EU nationals who are visa-exempt: Valid passport or travel document.
- Non-EU nationals with visa requirements: Valid passport with a Schengen or German national visa.

Additionally, non-EU travellers showing up at the German port of entry may be asked to present the following documents in order to be allowed to enter Germany:

- A passport or travel document. Issued within the last ten years and valid for at least three more months beyond their planned exit date from Germany.
- Proof of sufficient funds for the entire stay in Germany.
- A round-trip ticket to Germany and back.
- Travel insurance coverage for the entire stay in Germany.

Ensure that the German border officer stamps your passport if you are permitted to enter. Without a stamp, you could be fined or detained in Germany.

Passports:

Please ensure that your passport is still valid for at least three more months beyond their planned exit date from Germany and issued within the last ten years.

Visas:

Airports

Cologne Bonn Airport (CGN)

The nearest airport is the Cologne Bonn Airport (CGN), an international airport of Cologne that also serves Bonn. The airport is approximately 16 kilometers northeast of Bonn.

Frankfurt Airport (FRA)

International airport is 160 kilometers away from Bonn, but well connected via train.

Düsseldorf Airport (DUS)

About 80 kilometers away from Bonn.
