## Second High Level Forum on Global Geospatial Information Management Doha, Qatar, 4-6 February 2013

I am pleased to announce that the UN-GGIM Secretariat, in collaboration with the Government of Qatar, through its Ministry of Municipality and Urban Planning and Qatar Statistics Authority, will be hosting the Second High Level Forum on Global Geospatial Information Management (GGIM) in Doha, Qatar from 4-6 February 2013 at the Qatar National Convention Centre.

The program for the Forum begins on Sunday, 3 February 2013 with an 'Exchange Forum with the Geospatial Industry'. The main Forum begins on Monday, 4 February 2013, with an opening ceremony and ministerial segment, followed by various technical sessions on a range of topics.
