Request to work on terminology and concepts from the 1st meeting

"Start process of arriving at common terminology - collect existing information on terms, meanings, identify gaps, etc."



First proposal in Lisbon 2015

- 4. seek agreement by the expert group;*
- 5. transfer the terminology to a web-repository.*
