


The general legal framework



- ⇒ The article 55 fraction II of the Law of the National System of Statistical and Geographical Information establishes the INEGI's functions between these to regulate the statistical and geographical activities.
- ⇒ The article 98 of the Law of the National System of Statistical and Geographical Information establishes that Public Service of Statistics and Geographic Information is to make available to users, subject to the rules for that purpose issued by the Government Board, all of the Information of National Interest.
- □ In accordance with the legal dictation, the INEGI makes available to users all the information that it generated in the System, this means that all Statistical and Geographical Information is public and free.

The rules approved by the Government Board Aerial surveys Rule for the authorization of aerial surveys and geographical explorations in the country: ■ Establishes arrangements for issuing authorizations for individuals or corporations, domestic or foreign persons can capture aerial photographs with metric cameras or recognition and other images by remote sensing within the national airspace, and for the lifting of geographic information of the country.



The rules approved by the Government Board Open Data



- ➡ Technical standard for access and publishing Open Data of Statistical and Geographic Information of National Interest:
 - Establishes that the State Units must provide access to Information as Open Data.
 - Publics
 - Free of charge
 - Nondiscriminatory
 - Free use
 - Open Formats
 - machine readable
 - Integral
 - Primary
 - Timely
 - Permanent



The rules approved by the Government Board Open Data



⇒ **Terms of free use** of information from INEGI. The user:

Can **make and distribute copies** of the information, without altering or deleting metadata.

Can disseminate and publish the information.

Can adapt and reorder information.

Can extract all or part of information.

Can **commercially exploit the information**, using it as a resource to produce other products or services.


Must give credit for the INEGI as an author or who to correspond according to de case, and if technically possible, mention the source of information extraction as follows:

Source: INEGI, product name from which information is extracted and if applicable date update.

Why does the INEGI decide a politics of open data?



- □ Information of National Interest generated by the State Units is a public resource value, that being available as Open Data, and through its employment, helps to improve economic growth, strengthen competitiveness and promote innovation, increase transparency and accountability and to generate greater government efficiency and increase quality in the provision of public services.
- ➡ Information of National Interest is generated by the taxes of all citizens of Mexico, then they do not have to pay for the information is theirs.
