- Landlocked Sahelian country in West Africa
- 274 200 Km²
- 19 million inhabitants
 - 52% women
 - +75% rural
 - +55% Under 20
- Administrative subdivision: 13 regions, 45 provinces, 351 communes (49 urban and 302 rural communes) and 8228 villages

I. Land Tenure Project

- ❑ Compact signed in July 2008,
- ❑ \$480.9 million
- ❑ 5 years (2010-2014)

To reduce poverty through growth economic in four project

- Agriculture;
- Land tenure;
- Roads;
- Girls' education.

I. Land Tenure Project

- ❑ **Goal:** to increase investment in land and rural productivity through improved land security and land management,
- ❑ **Expected results:** increased confidence in the land security and increased efficiency of the institutions in charge of the land
- ❑ **3 components**
 - Component 1: “Legal and procedural change and communication”
 - Component 2: “Institutional Development and Capacity Building”
 - Component 3: “Site-specific land interventions”

II. Communication strategy
