

A "public domain" label?

Not good enough for many users

Apply open data licenses

- E.g. CCO, PDDL
- A "public domain dedication"
- Legally waives copyright
- Expands data access
- Aligns with Evidence Act

But are there restrictions?






The lack of standardized data handling is one of the biggest impediments to streamlined throughput


- Dataset specific


Creative Commons Licenses

- Well-known, internationally recognized
- Recommended for U.S. gov't data (CC0 1.0)
- Accommodates External Data scenarios

- Attribution (BY)—must give credit to provider
- NonCommercial (NC)—commercial use prohibited
- ShareAlike (SA)—products must maintain license
- NoDerivs (ND)—derivative products prohibited
