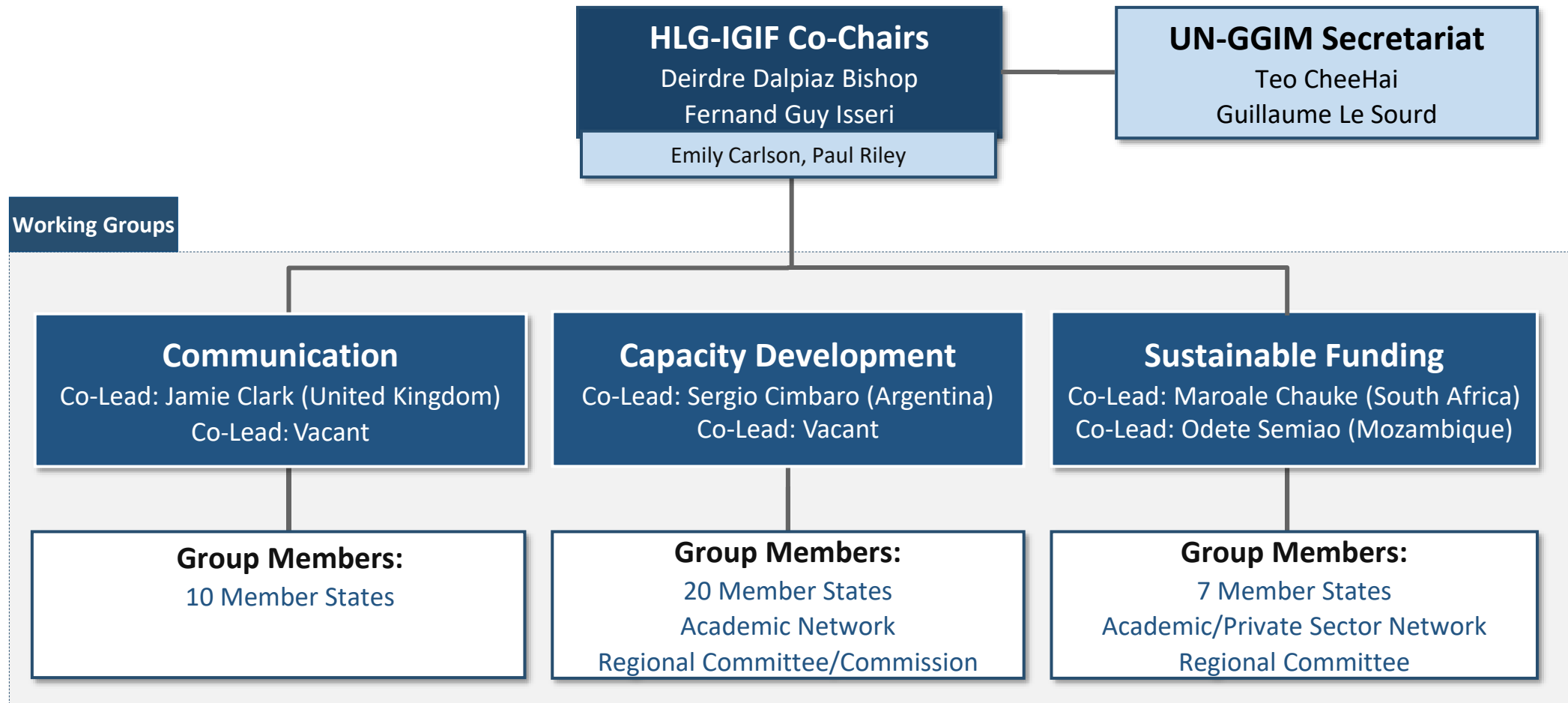

Improve Communication

- ❖ Developed Case Study Template and first case study on Sustainable Palm Oil Production in Indonesia.
- ❖ Developing new case studies and communication materials.
- ❖ Shared UN-IGIF at regional/global events, workshops, and meetings – encouraging collaboration and engagement.

IMPACTS

Strong regional and global collaboration and engagement on UN-IGIF. UN-IGIF featured strongly at regional events, workshops, meetings.

Strengthen Capacity Development

- ❖ Published UN approach to advance UN-IGIF.
- ❖ Overarching Strategy, Solving the Puzzle Chapters updated.
- ❖ UN-IGIF documents being translated into 7 languages.
- ❖ Global UN-IGIF Survey implemented to determine where/how UN-IGIF is utilized.
- ❖ Regional capacity development workshops.

Increasing number of partners engaging on capacity building and training. Increasing numbers of Member States advancing the UN-IGIF.

Mobilize Sustainable Funding

- ❖ Completed a review of Sustainable Funding literature.
- ❖ Completed focused global consultations with treasury ministers, geospatial contacts, donors, and the World Bank.
- ❖ Developed GeoVSI online tool to help justify investment in UN-IGIF.
- ❖ Drafting Sustainable Funding Guide.

UN-IGIF Global Survey

The HLG-IGIF conducted a global UN-IGIF survey with all 193 Member States. From the survey we learned:

- ✓ 18 Member States are advancing UN-IGIF with support from the SDG Data Alliance
- ✓ These respondents are from Africa, the Americas, Asia Pacific, and Europe
- ✓ Their responses support the importance and value of the SDG Data Alliance

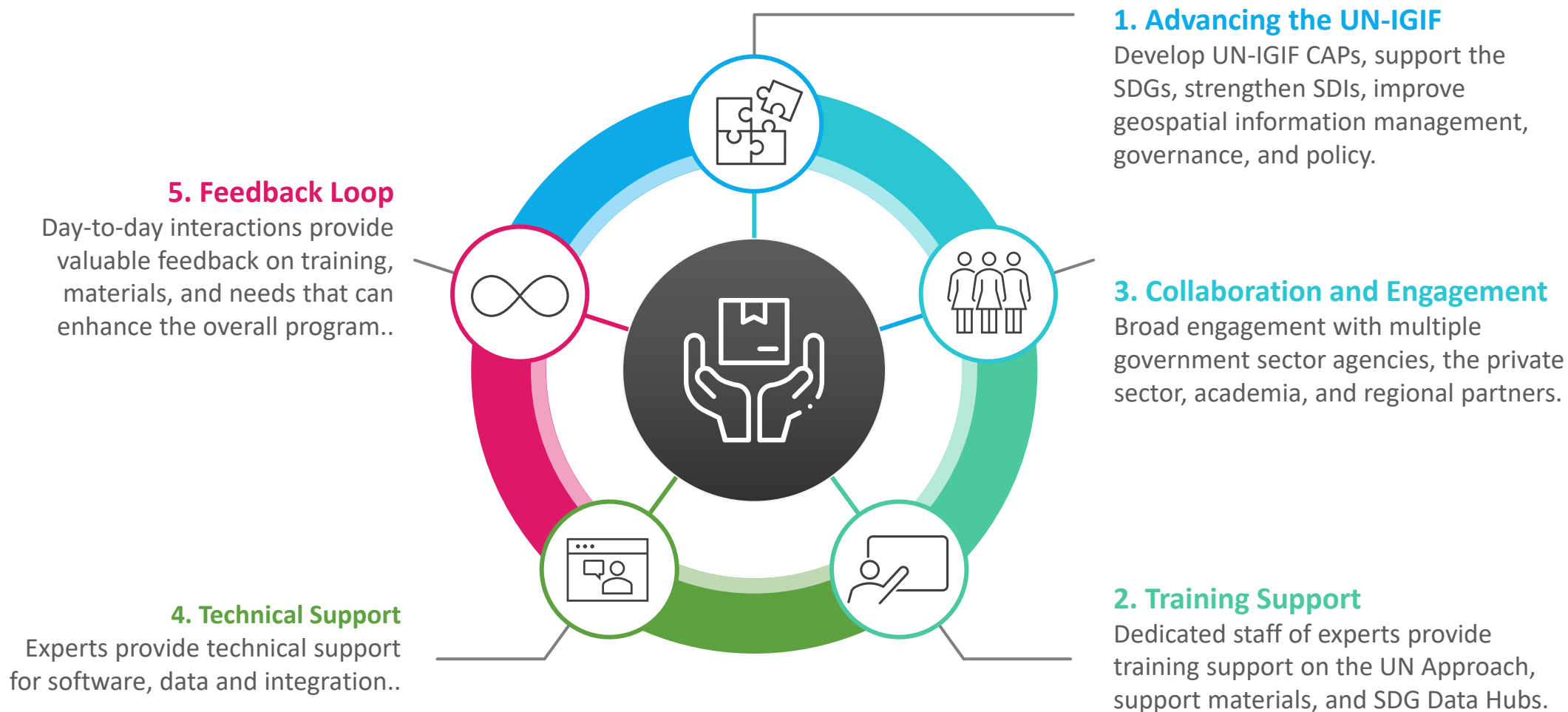
