- **14 of its members are regularly and actively participating on the different tasks and activities.**

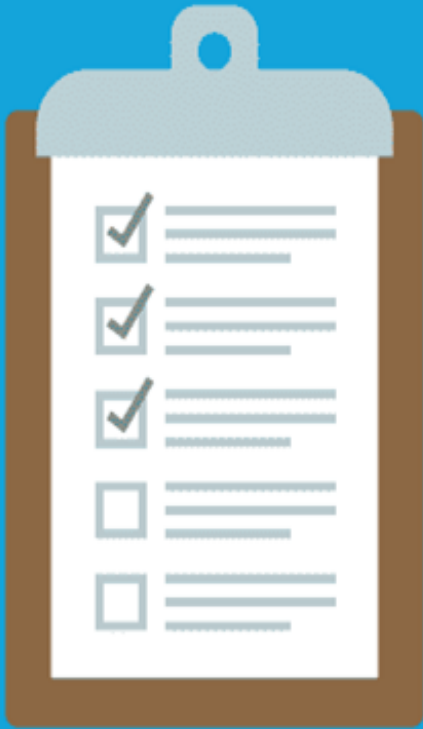
- **The group has representation of all five Regional Committees of the UN-GGIM, the Secretariat, as well as of the Academic Network of Americas & ECLAC**
