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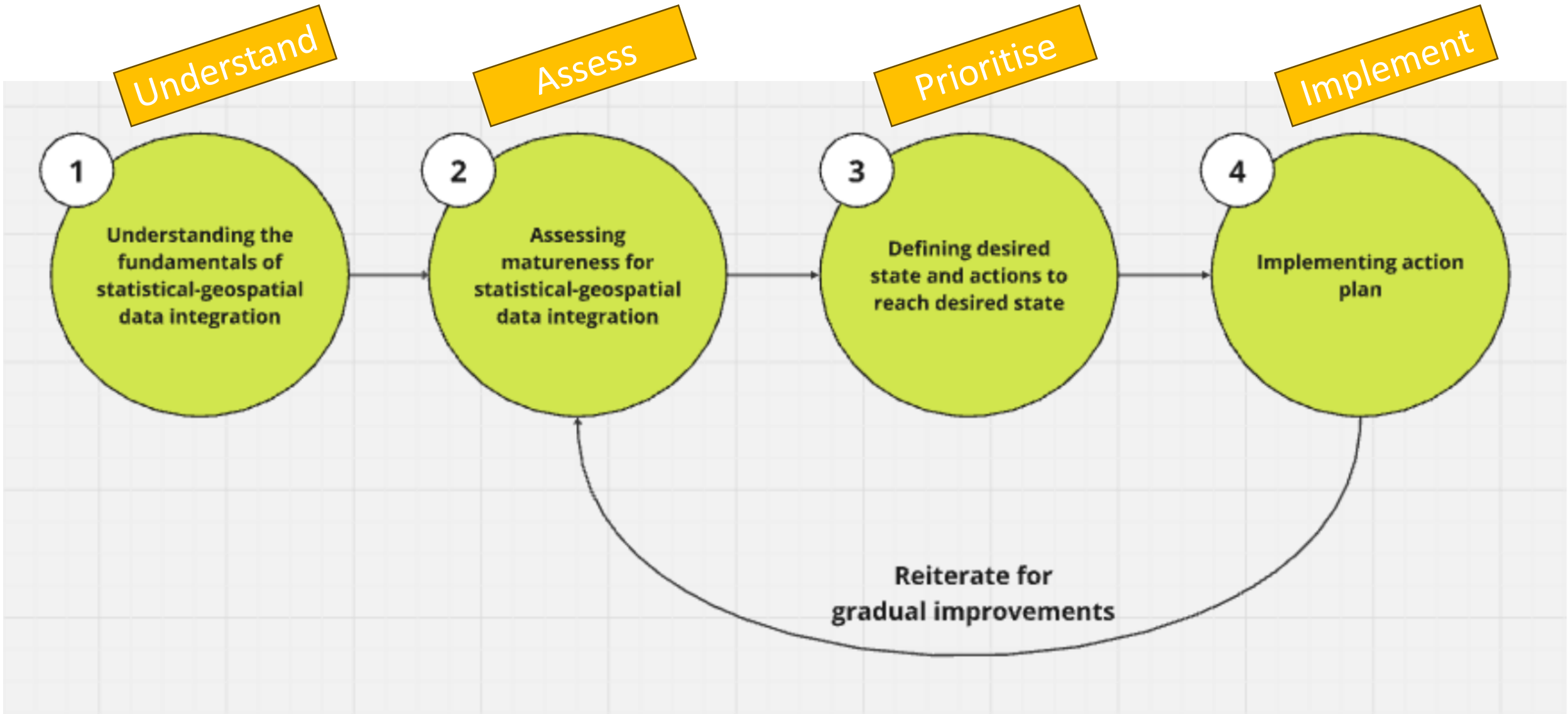


Figure 1. The four phases to operationalize the GSGF

- Guidance to support ALL phases
- The EG ISGI needs to be fit to meet the growing requests to support capacity development globally
- A new coordination architecture to build statistical-geospatial data integration capacity. Involving the EG ISGI as a matchmaking service and facilitator in partnership with regional commissions, UN bodies, development programs, funders and more.
