


## **Apia Commonwealth Ocean Declaration**



8. We **emphasise** the universal and unified character of the 1982 *UN Convention on the Law of the Sea* (UNCLOS) and **reaffirm** that UNCLOS sets out the legal framework within which all activities in the ocean and seas must be carried out. We **affirm** the freedoms, rights and duties of all states, including the rights and duties of coastal states in their maritime zones, as set out in UNCLOS. We **reaffirm** our commitment to sustainable ocean governance under UNCLOS, ......

13. In view of the urgent threat of climate change-related sea-level rise, and the fundamental need to secure the rights, entitlements, and interests of all states and peoples of the Commonwealth, **affirm** that members can maintain their maritime zones, as established and notified to the Secretary-General of the United Nations in accordance with UNCLOS, and the rights and entitlements.....

9 out of 48 shared boundaries under treaty


(dashed blue lines)

# Pacific Maritime Boundaries; Current






- 36 out of 48 shared boundaries are under treaty
- 7 treaties remain to be brought into force (yellow)
- 12 shared boundaries remain to be signed (pink)
- 5 countries high seas
   limits have yet to be declared

#### **IHO S-121 Digital Data Deposit with UN DOALOS**






**Prime Use Case** – state discharge of "depository obligations" under UNCLOS or a new open access method for providing and exchanging digital representations of MLBs
