








Survey Purpose

Provides insights into:












A total of 143 responses were received, representing 114 out of 193 UN-GGIM Member States.

Key Finding: Respondents demonstrate a substantial level of awareness and adoption of the UN-IGIF.



Results analysis compare the Member States currently using/implementing the UN-IGIF (Group of 66), and the Member States that are considering using/implementing it soon (Group of 27).




Key Finding: Collaborative efforts among strategic public sector agencies, as well as across the public, private, and academic sectors.

Leading UN-IGIF Initiatives and Uses of UN-IGIF




Key Finding: Effective geospatial management depends on collaboration between core public agencies, such as the geospatial, statistical, and governance/policy agencies.

Key Finding: Member States are implementing or considering the UN-IGIF for a variety of purposes beyond the development of a Country-level action plan.







Key Finding: Member States generally find the UN-IGIF guiding documents to be useful or highly beneficial.





Key Finding: A moderate number of Member States are creating and sharing their own UN-IGIF materials.



Funding for the Implementation of the UN-IGIF



Key Finding: While there is strong reliance on government funding, concerns remain about the adequacy of resources for ongoing implementation.



Main Conclusions

- > The implementation of UN-IGIF represents a pivotal step for Member States
- Generally favorable perception among Member States
- Contrasts between Member States in stages of implementation
- Concerns about substantial reliance on government funding
