Fifth Plenary Meeting of the High-level Group of the Integrated Geospatial Information Framework

Jeddah Hilton, Jeddah, Saudi Arabia 2 – 3 February 2025

Background

The High-level Group of the Integrated Geospatial Information Framework (HLG-IGIF) is actively implementing its Strategic Plan and Plan of Work to provide the strategic leadership, promotion, coordination, planning and oversight for the global uptake and implementation of the United Nations Integrated Geospatial Information Framework (UN-IGIF). In 2021, the group prioritized three goals for immediate action: improve communication, strengthen capacity development, and mobilize sustainable funding. To advance these goals, three work groups were created during the First Plenary Meeting on April 26-28, 2022. Since then, the HLG-IGIF has made significant progress on these priorities.

At the Third Plenary in January 2024 in Aguascalientes, Mexico, the HLG-IGIF reviewed and recommended updates to the Strategic Plan. The recommendations from the HLG-IGIF and attending partners included streamlining, prioritizing, and reducing duplication. As a result, the Strategic Plan was revised, reducing the number of goals from six to four by merging related goals. The HLG-IGIF established several key priorities including: 1) Strengthen communication strategy, objectives, and support materials for the UN-IGIF. 2) Finalize, translate, and publish all UN-IGIF documents and resource materials, and evaluate if changes are needed. 3) Establish a central repository/website with all available documents and materials related to the UN-IGIF, including links to resources and e-Learning. 4) Establish a strong working relationship with the UN-GGKIC. 5) Re-evaluate the role of the HLG-IGIF in light of the UN-GGKIC and expanded Secretariat, and consider if a more strategic approach is needed.

During the Fourth Plenary Meeting in August 2024 in New York, the Strategic Plan was adopted and the HLG-IGIF Work Groups presented proposed changes to the work plans based on the updated Strategic Plan and the HLG-IGIF priorities established in Aguascalientes. Recognizing the new United Nations Global Geospatial Knowledge and Innovation Centre (UN-GGKIC) and the expanded Secretariat, the HLG-IGIF noted the need for clarification of roles and responsibilities. The HLG-IGIF Work Plan was approved, with the understanding that it would be revisited in the near future to better align with the new UN-GGKIC and the expanded Secretariat.

At the Fifth Plenary meeting, the HLG-IGIF will review the UN-IGIF specific 2025 priority activities and associated needs as identified by the HLG-IGIF Work Groups, UN-GGKIC, UN-GGIM Regional Committees, Secretariat, and the SDG Data Alliance. The group will focus on clearly defining roles, responsibilities, and collaboration requirements. Each identified priority will be assessed to ensure it has a designated lead, with contributors and stakeholders clearly outlined. This assessment will help the group to finalize the HLG-IGIF work plan, and ensure a well-defined roadmap for 2025 that takes into account the additional resources anticipated from the UN-GGKIC and UN-GGIM Secretariat.
