responsibility for outcomes.


















Geospatial Leadership

- Enacting Transformation.




















Empowering the Implementation of the UN-IGIF

- How do we all ensure balance between innovation and ethical governance to ensure geospatial technologies support just, inclusive, and sustainable outcomes?














Challenges Identified

- Lack of (or insufficient) governance legal/policy frameworks for interagency collaboration
- 2. Unconvinced **buy-in** from highest-level decision makers (cabinet)
- Lack of qualified GIS professionals, enhancing geospatial skillset
- 4. Lack of data standard and infrastructure
- Sustaining financial investment either from national or private sectors in geospatial programs
- Limited global and regional coordination and participation for policy alignment
- Sustaining institutional memory free from political changes in the country
