

## The Scope of Integrated Land Administration and Planning Project

- 1. Provision of Spatial Planning Documents includes 10 RTR-KSN at a scale of 1:50,000 (regional spatial planning) and 500 Detailed Spatial Planning (Component 1)
- Strengthening Land Tenure Security and Landscape Management, including Cadastral Maps; Results of Inventory and Identification of Customary Land, Definitive Boundary Maps for 5,000 villages (Component 2)
- 3. Value-Added Zone (ZNT) Maps, both updates of existing maps and new ZNT Maps (Component 3)
- 4. Large-Scale Base Maps of Land Areas for the entire territory of the Republic of Indonesia except for Sulawesi Island (already using the 2024 State Budget) (Component 4)
