

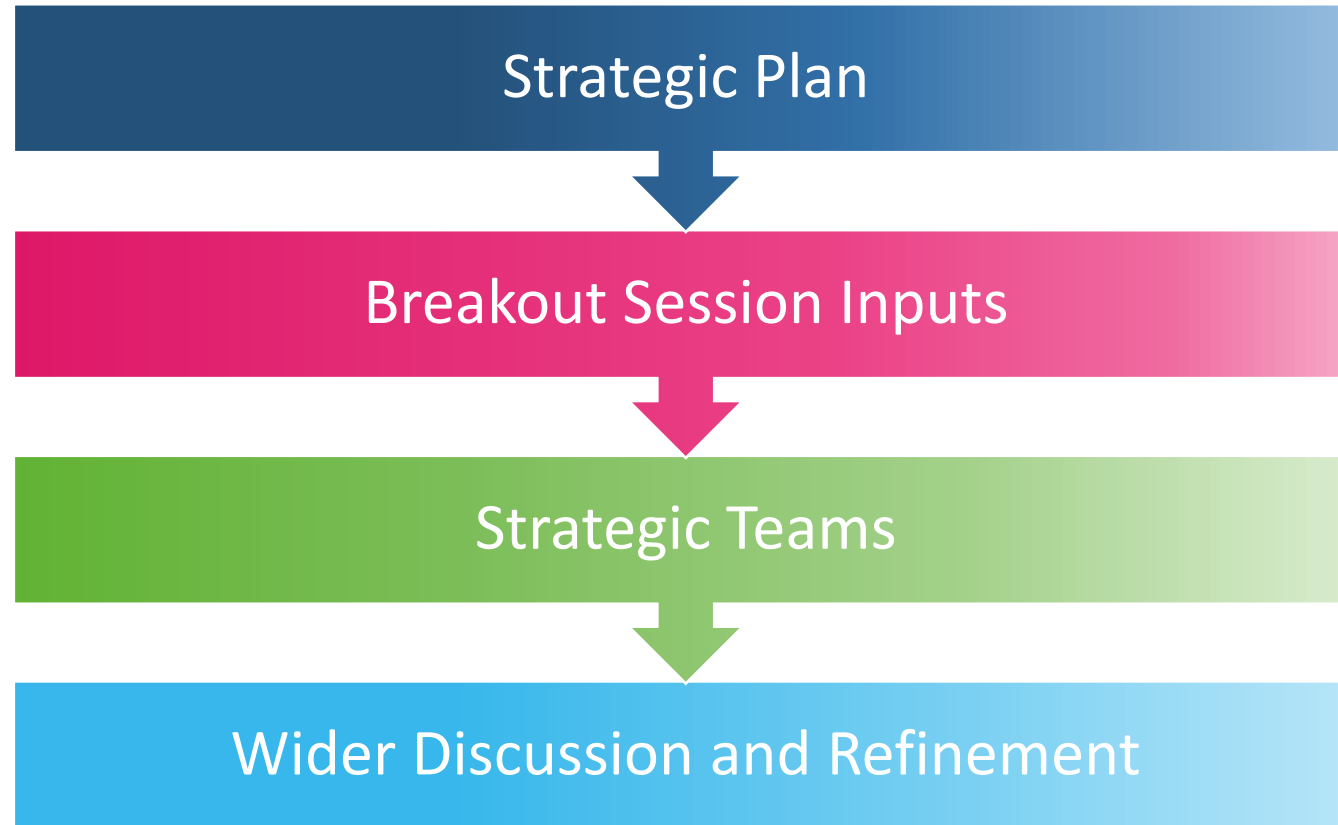

What key outcomes or deliverables would indicate success for this team?

5 Stakeholders

What perspectives or stakeholders should be included on this Strategic Team?
