### Implementation and adoption of standards for the global geospatial information community (for information)

<i>Statement provided by:</i> MEXICO	
<i>Statement:</i> <p>Mexico recognizes the collective efforts of the Open Geospatial Consortium (OGC), Technical Committee 211 of the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) and the International Hydrographic Organization (IHO), in the use of geospatial standards in support of the measurement and monitoring of the Sustainable Development Goals and in the guidance of how to apply the standards for the Implementation Guide of Integrated Geospatial Information Framework.</p> <p>Mexico supports the work undertaken by the OGC regarding the development of standards based on application of programming interfaces for the integration of geospatial information with statistics and other types of data, which will allow countries to make better use of information from both domains. In this sense, INEGI is working on the construction of the geostatistical framework as a mechanism for the integration of geospatial information with statistics.</p> <p>Mexico considers that, in order to achieve interoperability of geospatial information and for it to be shared without borders, it is necessary to adopt the standards that the aforementioned organizations have developed.
