<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Canada commends the Expert Group on its efforts over the past year to develop and consult broadly on the Global Statistical Geospatial Framework (GSGF).</li><li>• Consistent with Canada’s position at the UN Statistical Commission, Canada continues to endorse the Global Statistical Geospatial Framework (GSGF) by the Committee of Experts.</li><li>• Canada suggests the continued exploration of avenues for testing the application of the GSGF on a regional, multilateral level.</li><li>• Canada will continue to participate in institutional coordination and collaboration between the national statistical organization and the national geospatial agency and other relevant partners in the implementation of the GSGF.</li><li>• Canada will continue to participate in the Expert Group and in the next steps of the work plan for the period 2020–2022 to support the adoption and implementation of the Framework, including continuing the development of key statistical standards and processes to strengthen the integration of statistical and geospatial information.</li></ul>
