Statement:

- **1.** UN-GGIM: Africa welcomes the report of the Standards Development Organizations (SDOs) and further express its appreciation of the work of the three organizations to support implementation of standards-based solutions that ensure interoperability, data sharing across jurisdictions and platforms.
- **2.** The Africa region endorses the Third Edition of the Standards Guide as a living document to be complemented with examples of practices in geospatial standards implementations and user stories at national and regional level.
- **3.** Noting that countries from Africa currently participating in ISO/TC211 are very few and this is a serious concern, UN-GGIM: Africa has recently started discussion and has initiated the process for a liaison relationship between the Regional Committee and ISO/TC-211. It's the hope that this will not only provide exposure but will entice our Member States to start engaging in standards development nationally.
