Cameroon recognizes the importance of the Integrated Geospatial Information Framework which highlights the crucial and fundamental interest of the national spatial data infrastructure, and also provides guidance, options and actions to plan, develop and implement an integrated system.2. Cameroon takes note of the report and expresses its gratitude to the Secretariat for the continuous efforts in improving and finalizing the IGIF implementation guide. It also approves the formal establishment of the High Level Panel of the Integrated Geospatial Information Framework and the composition of its members.3.
