### Statement:

#### Oral Statement from UN-GGIM: Europe

- UN-GGIM: Europe commends the HLG-IGIF's progress and plan, noting the six strategic goals
  which we believe provide a strong guiding structure for the Framework's implementation and
  sustainability and are applicable for all countries; we especially note the importance of
  communication, promotion and knowledge sharing.
- Interlinking the IGIF with other regional and global frameworks will maximise resources and benefits, avoiding duplication of efforts or competition with overlapping programmes. We suggest that a powerful move is to embed the IGIF in UN frameworks which already enjoy high political awareness and funding.
- We share the concern of inadequate resources for the IGIF, including for resourcing the completion of the Implementation Guide and Strategic Pathways.

## Oral statement from Sweden

- As the distinguished members of UN-GGIM Europe addressed in their intervention, Sweden also commends the HLG-IGIF's progress and plan and endorse the Strategic Plan
- Sweden emphasis, on behalf of the HLG-IGIF the need of resources to be engaged and active in the work with the three prioritize goals, as well the refinement and finalization of the "Implementation Guide".
  - The Implementation Guide is the foundation for the rest of the future work of the HLG and is the most critical cog in the IGIF suite of products and resources.
