Statement:

Malaysia was honored and privileged to be part of IGIF global consultation and welcome the efforts to further develop and refine the Implementation Guide of the IGIF, as a means of strengthening national geospatial information management at the institutional level and supporting the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals.
