Background

The United Nations Integrated Geospatial Information Framework (IGIF) provides an overarching paradigm to further strengthen nationally integrated geospatial information management and maximizing geospatial information management and related resources in all countries. At its tenth session, the United Nations Committee of Experts on Global Geospatial Information Management (UN-GGIM) established a dedicated High-level Group of experts, with balanced geographical representation and expertise, as a mechanism to provide strategic leadership, coordination, and oversight to ensure the sustained success of the IGIF, and to mobilize the resources necessary to maintain the momentum and refinement of the IGIF as a continuously evolving process; the High-level Group on the Integrated Geospatial Information Framework (HLG-IGIF).

At its eleventh session, the Committee of Experts adopted decision 11/103, in which it endorsed the Strategic Plan of the High-level Group, including its six defined goals and focus actions, and supported the three priority goals identified for immediate attention, as an essential step towards the continued success and relevance of the IGIF. One of the three priority goals is to mobilize appropriate resources and funding to support the planning and operationalization of the IGIF at the country-level.

This side event seeks to bring together experts in the world of funding, with recipients of donor funding and Member States to identify and understand potential funding sources and requirements. Lessons will be shared from funder, donor and recipient perspectives on funding requirements and benefits realized.
