Dear Chair and Colleagues,

On behalf of OGC, IHO and ISO TC 211, I am pleased to introduce our latest report on implementing and adopting standards for the global geospatial information community.

With the full return to face-to-face meetings, the global community has accelerated its work providing practical and clearly demonstrable standards-based implementations for critical domains such as climate, disasters, marine and the built environment.
