CONCEPT NOTE

Background

Three standards development organizations (SDOs) have been working with UN-GGIM to encourage the use and practical testing of open standards when developing systems to plan for, implement, monitor, and report on work in support of the UN Sustainable Development Goals. The three SDOs are the Open Geospatial Consortium (OGC), ISO/TC 211 Geographic Information, and the International Hydrographic Office (IHO).

Part of this support is through the "Online Guide to the Role of Standards In Geospatial Information Management" ("Standards Guide"). In addition, the SDOs have engaged with different UN-GGIM regional, functional, and thematic groups.

The online version of the Standards Guide was presented during the week of the 12th session of the Committee of Experts: http://standards.unggim.ogc.org/index.php

Several countries have now implemented systems using open standards, either with the support of the SDG Data Alliance or in direct partnership with local or international companies.

In this session, we will:

- present user stories illustrating the use of geospatial open standards in support of SDG activities
- provide an update on SDO work in relation to "IGIF level 4: spatially enabled IT infrastructure".

Objectives and expected outcomes

Attendees should finish the session more aware of the benefits of using open standards and current and future practical activities and initiatives, and of the work the SDOs are doing to be prepared for a future with better integrated data infrastructure.
