


Survey Results Total Responses

Survey Results Use and Implementation of the UN-IGIF




Results analysis by the Capacity Development Working Group of the HLG-IGIF

The analysis compare the Member States currently using/implementing the UN-IGIF (Group of 66), and the Member States that are considering using/implementing it soon (Group of 27).




Participating Agencies and Institutions



Key Finding: Collaborative efforts among strategic public sector agencies, as well as across the public, private, and academic sectors.








Key Finding: Member States are implementing or considering the UN-IGIF for a variety of purposes beyond the development of a Country-level action plan.










Stage of Implementation of the UN-IGIF
