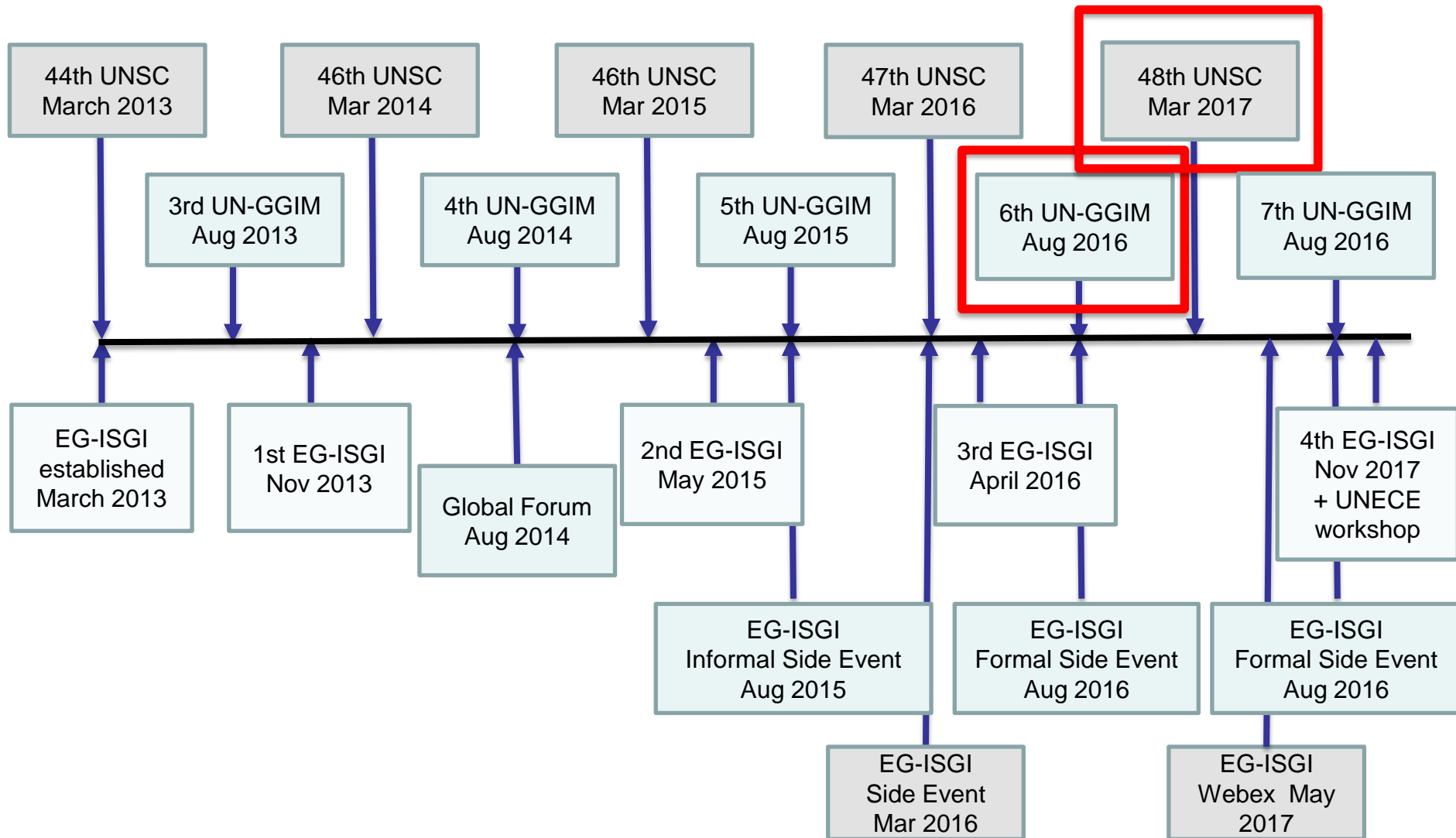

# Global Statistical Geospatial Framework: Timeline

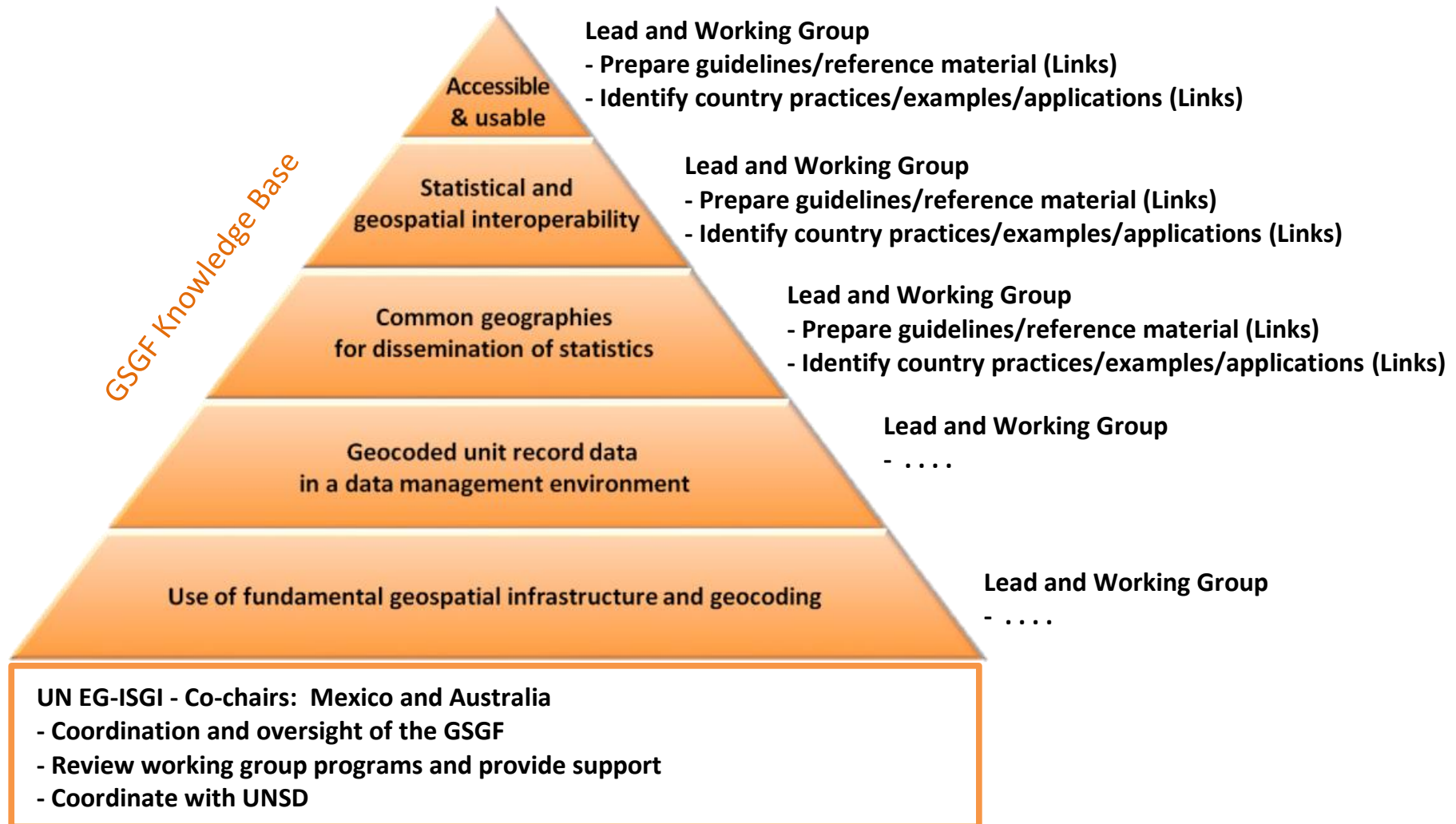


# Looking Forward

- c) Express its views on the proposal that the Expert Group should actively contribute to the work of the 2020 Census Expert Group to promote the integration of statistical and geospatial information and the implementation of the GSGF;
- d) Provide guidance on strengthening the mandate of the Expert Group to become the overall coordination group for the integration of statistical and geospatial information, and the Expert Group's desire to align their efforts in this area with the strategic directions of the UNSC and UN-GGIM.
